Gattefossé, a leading supplier of specialty ingredients for the beauty and health industries, is strengthening its environmental performance through Poseidon, a cross-functional program that integrates water management across the entire product life cycle. From product design to manufacturing and end-of-life, the program demonstrates how responsible science can deliver measurable environmental impact while supporting industrial performance.

Poséidon: embedding responsible water management into every stage of production

Water is a strategic resource for Gattefossé's industrial activities, primarily used in equipment cleaning and manufacturing processes. Poseidon is built on the ambition to make water efficiency a core industrial practice rather than an isolated initiative.

The program focuses on three complementary pillars:

- Reducing water withdrawals by optimizing manufacturing and cleaning cycles
- Maximizing the reuse of water and energy already mobilized in production processes
- Integrating water considerations at the design stage, through eco-design principles

This approach mobilizes teams across R&D, HSE, Quality, Production and Industrial Maintenance, driving long-term changes in operational practices and fostering a shared culture of continuous improvement.

Measurable results and collective momentum

Beyond environmental gains, Poseidon has transformed industrial practices by actively engaging teams on the ground. Operator training, reassessment of existing standards and the testing of new cleaning methods have helped to embed water management sustainably into daily operations.

Key figures – Poseidon program, Gattefossé Headquarters workshops, France

- **-14%** water consumption per ton produced over two years
- **800,000 liters** of water saved in 2024 through optimized production campaigns
- **400,000 liters** saved via optimized cooling system shutdowns
- **32% reduction in gas consumption** thanks to heat recovery
- **-60% to -80% expected water savings** for industrial cleaning with the deployment of CIP (Cleaning-In-Place) systems
- **€2.2 million in planned investments (2026–2027)** to scale up the initiative

With Poseidon, Gattefossé reinforces its vision of an industry where **innovation, environmental responsibility and operational excellence progress together**. A new investment phase starting in 2026 will further reduce the company's water footprint and strengthen the resilience of its industrial sites.
